Russia-Ukraine War

February-March 2014 - to the present time

Russian armed invasion of Crimea in February-March 2014, occupation of the Crimea peninsula on **20 February 2014**.

The war in eastern Ukraine (Donbas) since April 2014.

Full-scale Russian invasion of Ukraine - 24 February 2022.

As of 2021, **43,300 square km of Ukrainian territory** was under Russian occupation.

Since 24 February 2022, the occupied area has increased by **2.9 times**.

Temporarily occupied are: the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, parts of Donetsk, Luhansk, Kharkiv, Kherson, Zaporizhzhya, Mykolaiv regions and the city of Sevastopol.

























UKRAINIAN PORTS DURING THE WAR




Almost all Ukrainian ports are closed due to occupation, blockade, mine danger, and the danger of the piracy by Russia.






UST-DUNAYSK SEA TRADING PORT

- sold at the ProZorro auction


